

myOHSAA NFHS Participation Survey

Step 1: Accessing *myOHSAA*

- Log onto <http://myohsaa.ohsaa.org> or access myOHSAA through the upper right corner or along the left side of the OHSAA homepage (www.ohsaa.org)
- At the log-in screen, enter your Username and Password.
- If you have forgotten your username or password, click “Forgot Password” and follow the instructions to have your user credentials emailed to you.
- Once logged in, click “Complete Now” at the prompt or “NFHS Survey” in the left navigation column to be taken to the NFHS Survey.

Step 2: Completion of the 2010-11 NFHS Participation Survey

Annually the National Federation collects from each member school the number of participants in each sanctioned sport and activity. Before completing the survey, schools will need to compile the number of male and female participants in the attached list of NFHS sports and activities.

- After entering the number of participants, click “Save”
- The survey can be accessed at any time until the June 25 deadline by clicking on “NFHS Survey” in the left navigation column.
