**School Stations (majority of work done by students) – no charge**

- b. Advertisement for alcohol, tobacco, drugs of any kind, gambling of any kind, political parties or candidates or any other advertising considered in poor taste are prohibited.
- c. Contests being televised by the OHSAA's official television partner, SportsTime Ohio, may also be televised on delay by "hometown" stations as long as the parameters established by the OHSAA are met (see page 2 of the manager's manual media section).
- d. All video coverage (telecasts or streaming) must be tape-delayed and may not begin prior to 10:00 p.m. the day of the game (or conflict with the air time of a SportsTime Ohio broadcast).
- e. Telecasts or web streams can be shown an unlimited number of times for two weeks following the contest. Airing contests after the two-week period will result in additional rights fees assessed.
- f. Selling video tapes of tournaments contests not aired by SportsTime Ohio is permitted. A donation of \$50 per sports season must be made to the OHSAA's 'Respect The Game' Sportsmanship Program.
