

Options Available for Catastrophic Insurance Coverage for Students in OHSAA Non-Recognized Sports

Since August 1, 2006, the OHSAA has no longer provided catastrophic insurance coverage for students who participate in sports not recognized by the OHSAA.

However, member schools should note that the OHSAA has endorsed Loomis & LaPann, Inc. to offer schools the opportunity to purchase catastrophic insurance coverage at a very reasonable cost for students who participate in sports not recognized by the Association.

Member schools also have an option to purchase Catastrophic Insurance that covers all school sanctioned activities such as school sponsored summer camps, field trips, open gym and other normal school activities. Also, when purchasing this option all non-recognized athletics are covered.
