Schools that permit coaches to coach (Paid or volunteer) without a valid Pupil Activity Certificate issued by the ODE will be fined \$250.00 per coach.

Each team in your program is permitted to schedule 1 scrimmage. You may use this scrimmage at any time during the season.

Out of State Travel

Please keep in mind the OHSAA's Regulation relative to 'out of state travel' that permits a team to travel to a bordering state an unlimited amount of times while limiting non-bordering state travel to ONE time per season with no school being permitted to be missed for the travel or competition. The penalty for violating this rule is tournament

After August 23, there will be a \$50.00 late fee to take the rules meeting and receive credit. The deadline *with* penalty is September 16 at 11:59 pm. There is no verification email or certificate at the end. As long as you watched all slides ending with the quiz slide, you will receive credit. Reminder emails will be sent out to AD's in August for those still needing to complete the rules meeting.

Non-Interscholastic Rule

As soon as your golfers compete in a scrimmage or match for your school team, they are no longer permitted to participate in any non-interscholastic events (scrambles, club championships, AJGA events, etc.). If they choose not to begin competing for the school team in order to play in one or multiple non-interscholastic events, they must return and begin competition with your school team by September 5th in order to be eligible for the OHSAA tournament. Note: Competing in Drive, Chip and Putt events is permitted anytime during the season.

Girls Playing on Boys Teams

For those of you who have individual girls competing on your boys teams during the regular season, the girls must tee-off from the same tees as the boys. Please note that during the regular season, girls cannot go back and forth between playing in girls and boys events.
