## 2012 OHSAA Volleyball State Tournament Coaches/Media Teleconference

The OHSAA will host a coaches/media teleconference on Monday, Nov. 5 with the head coaches of the schools that have reached the volleyball state tournament. The teleconference will allow media members the opportunity to ask questions of the coaches whose teams will play in the state tournament November 8-10.

The teleconference will begin at 10:00 a.m. and coaches will be available for 15 minutes each. The rotation will be Division IV first, followed by III, II, and I.
