state's small school basketball stars came in for their share of glory Wednesday as The Associated Press named its Class A All-Ohio high school team.

Dan Thallman, a 6-foot-6 phenom from Bloomville, won honors as the Class A player of the Year.

The senior center led Bloomville to a 21-2 season with a 32.7 point average and 22 rebounds a game.

MUCH-SOUGHT after by colleges, Thallman rang up 1,550 points in a brilliant three-year career and was a standout on defense.

The Dragons' star is joined in the first unit by Ted Sizemore of New Lebanon Dixie; Art "Butch" Haswell of Strasburg; Bill McMeans of North Lima; Jeff Reisinger

of Ross Zane Trace and Ty Crawmer of Licking Valley.

Reisinger and Crawmer are juniors, the others seniors.

Sizemore, a standout for Dixie, all season, scored at a 24.1 clip while Reisinger was the big gun that carried Zane Trace to an unbeaten season until Portsmouth Clay upset the Ross County school in the regional final at Athens. Reisinger averaged 22.5 points.

Haswell, an excellent floor man with a 19-point average, kept Strasburg in the No. 1 ranked position all season before his team fell in district play to Garaway.

CRAWMER, a 24-point shooter, was the big spark in Licking Valley's attack while the 6-7 McMeans rammed home 31 a contest for North Lima.

There's talent galore, too, on the second unit that consists of Granville's Gary Lawrence; Mike Battle of Lincoln Heights; Rich Davie of Sandusky St. Mary; Mark Thompson of Mount Pleasant; Mark Wagar of Avon and Tim Goss of Alexander. Davie is a junior.

Battle and Goss were second team picks a year ago while Thompson was a first squad selection.
