McDuffie, Borgerding head Class A allstate

Running backs O.J. McDuffie of Gates Mills Hawken and St. Henry's Tony Borgerding share back of the year honors...

In addition, Tony Closson of poll champion Delphos Jefferson was chosen the lineman of the year, with Fairport Harbor Harding's Wally Kesling the choice as Class A coach of the year.

McDUFFIE AND Borgerding combined to gain 3,088 yards.

McDuffie, a 5-foot-11, 175-pound junior, rushed 158 times for 1,470 yards, a 9.3 yards per carry average.

Borgerding, a 6-2, 195-pound

senior, carried the ball 261 times and totaled 1,618 yards, an average of 6.2 yards per carry. He scored 25 touchdowns.

Closson follows in the footsteps of his brother, Matt, who was the Class A lineman of the year as a senior for Delphos Jefferson in 1985.

KESLING WAS tabbed as top coach of the year for bringing Fairport Harbor Harding team with a 9-1 record despite finishing one game with 14 players.
