Season Opens On August 1!

Just as with the 2015 volleyball season, each year for the foreseeable future, coaching and instruction may begin on August 1. The exception to this rule is when August 1 falls on Sunday. In those years, the season will begin on August 2.

Last Chance to Review New Uniform Rules Before the 2016 Effective Date

Our staff has been spending quite a bit of time evaluating uniforms that our member schools have submitted to us electronically. We are happy to provide this service as we do not want schools to make an expensive mistake when ordering new uniforms to comply with the new rules in volleyball. If you are considering purchasing new uniforms for the 2016 season, please be sure that the uniforms are compliant with these new rules. These rules have been in the volleyball rules book for the last FOUR years, so we feel fairly confident that most schools are aware. We will also cover these again in the online rules meeting and include them in your volleyball manual. PLEASE BE ADVISED THAT THE PENALTY FOR NON-COMPLIANCE IS THE INABILITY TO USE A LIBERO PLAYER DURING THAT MATCH...

Beginning this season <u>- 2016 -</u> the libero shall wear a uniform top that is immediately recognized from all angles as being in clear contrast to and distinct from the other members of the team. The libero and/or her teammates shall wear a solid-colored uniform top. Regarding the solid-colored top:

- The solid color uniform top shall clearly contrast from the predominant color(s)
 of the teammates' uniform top. Predominant color(s) is the color(s) appearing on
 approximately half of the uniform.
- Sleeves shall be the same color as the body of the uniform top.
- Piping/trim not exceeding one inch (1") in total at its widest point may be placed along the seams and maybe a different color(s) than the uniform top.
- Lettering and colors may be a different color(s) than the uniform top.
- A single school name, mascot and/or player's name may be placed on the body of the uniform top, but shall not disrupt the integrity of the solid-colored uniform top.
 Designs are not permitted. A single mascot reference and/or school name may be placed on the sleeve(s), not to exceed 4 by 4 inches or 3 by 5 inches.
- Numbers shall be a contrasting color to the uniform top and meet all other specifications in Rule 4-2-4.
